



I have discovered through all these reflections the real purpose of going to college—to develop mentally, spiritually, socially, and physically. Now as you read and remember, may you be able to say . . .






EMC Became Part of My Life.

And never breathe a word about your loss;


If you can force your heart and nerve and sinew To serve your turn long after they are gone, And so hold on when there is nothing in you
