# **Hours of Operation**


### **Main Library**




- Stack books are loaned for 2 weeks and may be renewed online or at the Circulation Desk.

# A Guide to Your Library







### LIBRARY CARD

Your Oakwood University I.D. card is your library card.

### WEBSITE

The library website www.oakwood.edu/library is an important place for detailed information about library services and collections. The website provides access to the library catalog, periodical databases, and other useful electronic resources.

### LIBRARY CATALOG

The catalog lists books, e-books & media owned by the Eva B. Dykes Library.

### **INTERLIBRARY LOANS**

Books and articles not available at the Eva B. Dykes Library may be borrowed from other libraries. To place a request, complete the online form or contact 256-726-7248.

### **BORROWING SERVICES**

Borrow and return library materials, pay fines, and pick up books from Interlibrary Loan at the Circulation Desk on the main floor.

### **STUDY ROOMS**

There are 17 group study rooms, one conference room, 5 study carrels, and a classroom, available for 3-hour reservations. Make reservations on the library's website.



### REFERENCE SERVICES

Librarians provide assistance with all types of information questions, in person and online. Online chat and text messaging to librarians are available via the Ask Us tab on the library website.

### **CONSULTATIONS**

Individuals may schedule appointments with reference librarians when additional time is needed for research.



## **ELECTRONIC RESOURCES**

The library offers onsite and off-campus access to several

scholarly databases that support a cross-section of academic disciplines. Many of these databases provide full-text articles.

### **MEDIA RESOURCES**

We house and provide access to a myriad of audiovisual materials and equipment. Listening and viewing facilities are available for in-library use of materials. Laptops, cameras, LCD projectors, tablets and e-book readers are available for checkout.
