Dear Friends:

We have just received a box of 80 copies of Steps to Christ which you mailed to us on November 2. There has been some delay because of the recent war and that's why these did not come sooner, but we are very, very happy to receive them.

Your card said that they had been sent by Elder L. L. McKinley and I have written him a letter thanking him for his kindness.

Since all college education in India until very recently has been in English medium all of the educated people of this land speak English, therefore such books as Steps to Christ and Great Controversy are very effective here. The people are also very happy to read almost anything they get in their hands which we should take advantage of and see that the message for these last days is given to them in printed form.

We are presently experiencing an unprecedented evangelistic explosion in our field. We are actually receiving scores of invitations from various towns and villages appealing to us to come and give our message.

Since Babylon has fallen and the churches which comprised her are no longer willing to support a foreign mission program many of these missions has had to withdraw their workers from these villages. There are literally thousands of villages where there are groups of Christians without any pastors or teachers. They are as sheep without a shepherd. When we enter these villages with our message many of these Christians unite behind us, accept the truth and then work with us to bring their Hindu neighbors to Christ.

During the next three months, we will be having more than 100 evangelistic campaigns in various cities and villages. We need all the literature we can get especially, such great books as Great Controversy, and Steps to Christ, so thank you very much for remembering us. God bless you.
